Four Simple steps to make a Bequest:

2. Speak to your lawyer about drafting or revising your will, an essential step to protect your family's future and ensure your assets are distributed according to your intentions.
3. Include the appropriate wording in your will. For example:
"My estate trustees shall pay the sum of \$__or __% of residue of my estate (or transfer assets with an equal value) to Health Sciences North Foundation, Sudbury, ON, to support its most urgent funding needs. Charitable Business #89286 8480 RR0001.
